Dear Former Student,

We are in the final stages of making arrangements for the dispatch of certificates which arrived in the school in November.

- If you wish to collect your certificates in person, please present yourself to the main school office between 10am and 4pm, Monday to Friday.
- If you wish to nominate someone to collect your certificates, please return the attached reply slip specifying the name of the person who will be collecting them.
- If you wish for the school to post your certificates to an address, please return the attached reply slip with a cheque for £4.00 to cover the cost of postage (Signed for 2nd Class).

Please note that any certificates not collected by the end of March 2020 will be returned to the exam boards and that they levy a charge for certificates that have to be re-issued. The charge for this is approximately £40-£50 for each exam board.

Please note that exam boards are reluctant to issue replacement certificates if they are lost and AQA will not replace at all. It is important that all certificates are stored in a safe place for the future.
